Digital Media Guide

Game Schedule, Rosters, and Stats

- Game schedule, rosters, stats will be available on Tourney Machine and GameSheet. We highly recommend that you follow your team to receive important alerts and any schedule change announcements. Games are scheduled for Tuesday, July 1-Thursday, July 3rd.

Code of Conduct

- This is a very exciting time for all players, coaches and parents and we need to remind all attendees that while at the event, they are representing their families, program, and hometown both on and off the field.
- Please show respect towards the coaches, teammates, parents, opponents, officials, and tournament staff on and off the field. If a fan, player, or coach is ejected from a tournament game they will be prohibited to watch or participate in the following game. Fighting is an automatic ejection.
- During the LWSC activities being held at the events center, please keep in mind that we are guests. Please treat all spaces with respect. The use of lacrosse equipment in any hotels is prohibited. Parents and coaches – please use your best judgement in chaperoning the players throughout the weekend at both the field and hotel activities.
- We look forward to providing a safe and enjoyable experience for everyone.

- **Please note, the Events Center is part of a casino and all minors 14 years of age and younger must be at all times accompanied by a parent or guardian 18 years of age or older while on the property**
- **Please use the main Valley Forge Convention Center Doors on property. Entrance will be labeled with LWSC signage. Once you are in the building head left and downstairs to the event center. Refer to the map below on where to park and enter.**
- **Parking is free.**

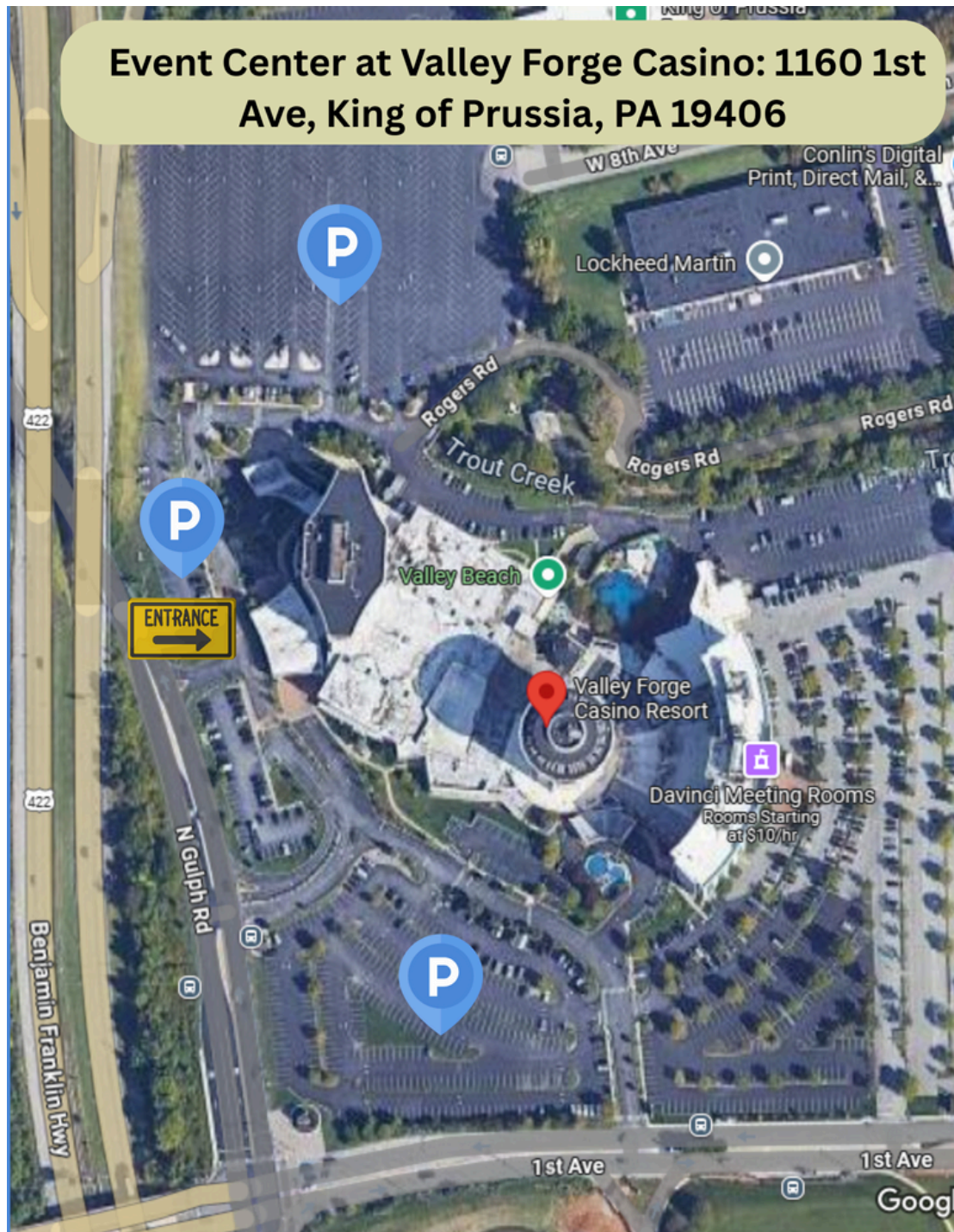


Welcome Ceremony: What to Expect

- The LWSC Welcome Ceremony is an exciting time for all teams and their families to officially kick off the four day event. Teams will get their photo taken and get checked in while parents, siblings, and friends can socialize and interact with each other. Once teams are done with photos and check-in, they can join the party and hangout with the twenty four teams in attendance. If your team has a late check-in window, you are more than welcome to arrive early to partake in the festivities but must make sure your team is ready to be checked-in during it's scheduled time. Concessions with sandwiches and snacks will be available downstairs while a food court will be upstairs with multiple food options. Multiple cash bars will be on site as well. Adults, please drink responsibly.
- The dress code is casual for parents. Coaches and Team Managers, please coordinate outfits for the team during their team picture. For reference, teams will wear matching polos, shirts, or jerseys for the team photo.

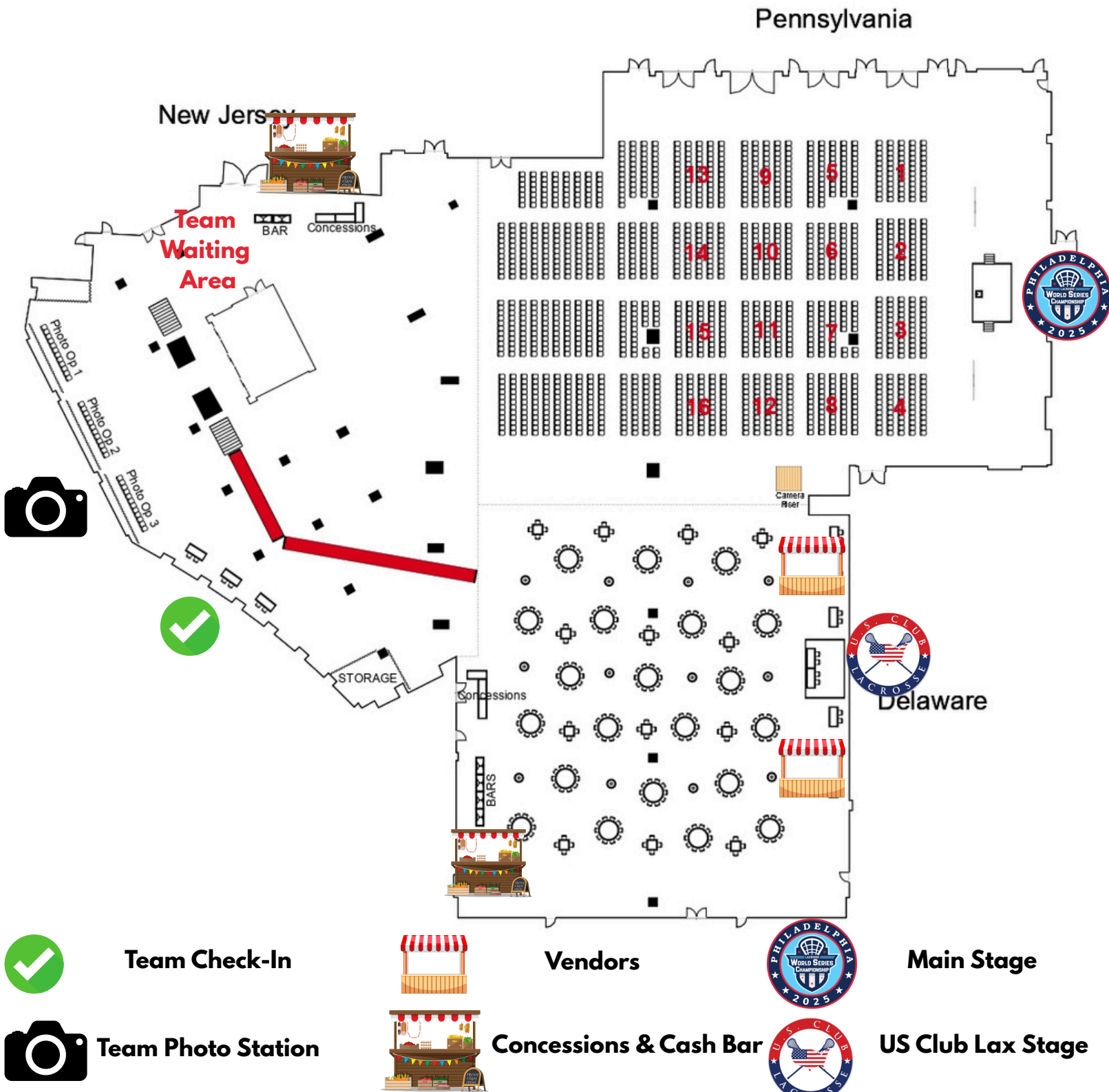


Parking Map

Welcome Ceremony Schedule of Events

- Team Photos and Team Check-in begin at 4PM at the Valley Forge Events Center Casino in the event center based on the schedule below. Teams are encouraged to arrive before their actual check-in times to experience the vendors and engagement opportunities.
- Team Photo and Team Check-in time slots will go from 4PM-5:30PM. There is a built in buffer if check-in runs behind.
- Welcome Ceremony will be from 6-6:30PM. Vendors will be open until 7PM.

- Only players and coaches are allowed to report to the team picture station and team check-in. Parents, please head towards the vendor village while the teams check-in. Coaches, please assist in having your team arrive on time and ready. We will have staff available to help organize your team so team photos and check-in can be done in a 10- minute window.
- The Event Center will be labeled on where to line up and wait to make the team photo and check-in process run efficiently.
- Each player needs to check in and pick up their gear personally. Parents or teammates are not allowed to pick up swag bags for any other player.
- For players that can't pick up their swag bags, we will give the team coaches their bags.
- During the team photo and check-in period from 4-5:30PM, there will be vendors on site selling merchandise in the pre-function space of the events center.

Game Schedule: Tuesday-Wednesday

- All LWSC games, rosters, and stats can be followed on the tourney machine app and can be found here: [LWSC 2025 Game Schedule](#)
- We highly recommend to follow your team to receive important alerts and any schedule change announcements.
- Tuesday, July 1st.
 - Teams are placed in four pools of six teams. On Tuesday, all teams will play three games from 9AM-4PM.
- Wednesday, July 2nd
 - Teams will wrap up pool play with their two remaining games from 9AM-2PM. After each team has completed all their games, teams will be ranked 1-24 with the top two teams from each pool making the playoff bracket.
- Tie Breakers among the pools are: Record, Head to Head, Goals Allowed, Goal Differential, Goals Scored, Coin Flip
- Tie Breakers among the entire division are: Record, Pool Place, Head to Head, Goals Allowed, Goal Differential, Goals, Scored, Coin Flip
- There will be no other activities after pool play is complete. Teams will have the ability to coordinate team outings and dinners for Wednesday evening.
- Top 100 Skills Competition
 - Top 100 Sports will be operating the skills competition on both Tuesday and Wednesday on field 5. Top 100 sports uses the latest technology to record player measurables and provides a unique atmosphere creating competition among all the players. The two main drills Top 100 sports will be measuring are the 40 yard dash and the fastest shot.



Game Schedule: Thursday: Championship Day

- **Thursday, July 3rd**
 - **Playoff games, consolation games, and championship game.**
 - **All teams will play at least one game on Thursday July 3rd.**
 - **Teams are encouraged to stay through the championship game to partake in the flag procession.**
 - **All games will be played at United Sports, including the championship game. Please note, we will not be leaving the facility for the championship game.**
 - **We will be engineering the stadium feel with more bleachers, DJ, live stream, locker rooms, and flag procession all on fields 1 and 2.**
 - **Playoff and consolation games will be from 8AM-11:30AM**
- **Championship Teams**
 - **After the completion of the 10:20AM Semi Final Games, winners from each game will head inside the United Sports Field House to their designated locker rooms.**
 - **This process will take around 45 minutes to complete uniform set up. Expect locker rooms to be ready around 12:15-12:30PM.**
 - **Championship teams warm up on Field 1 from 12:45PM-1:20PM**
- **Timing of Championship and Flag Procession**
 - **Non championship teams will have around 2-4 hours to unwind, head back to the hotel if available, get some food, and come back for the flag procession.**
 - **1:10PM - Non championship teams get ready for flag procession on field 2. There will be markers on where to line up. Please avoid bringing your gear and make sure you have your team flag.**
 - **1:20PM - Championship teams head back to locker rooms**
 - **1:30PM - Flag Procession starts**
 - **1:48PM - Captains recognized**
 - **1:55PM - Championship teams walk out**
 - **1:57PM - National anthems**
 - **2:00PM - Championship game starts**



Championship Game

- **The Championship game will be live streamed via US Club Lax with announcers on YouTube. A live stream link will be sent to all families and made publicly available on Wednesday evening.**
- **During halftime of the championship game, All Tournament Team Awards will be presented to the selections. All tournament teams will be announced by 10AM on Thursday via email and social media.**
- **Player selection will be based on the following criteria**
 - **Team Performance**
 - **Coach Nominations: We will send a form to coaches on 7/1 to be completed the evening of 7/2 by 8PM.**
 - **Independent evaluators**
 - **Player statistics**
 - **Please note, not all teams are guaranteed to have a player represented on the all tournament teams.**
- **Championship game and tournament will end with the presentation of the Championship Trophy.**

Tournament Rules

Tournament Rules o Rules for the LWSC can be found [here](#). Please review all rules in advance of game play.

Points of emphasis:

- **Each game is four (4)- eleven (11) minute running quarters with two-minute breaks and five minute halftime.**
- **When the ball is dead, either a head coach or a player on the field may call a timeout.**
- **During live play, timeouts may be called from anywhere on the field only by a member of a team in possession or by that team's head coach.**
- **Each team has one (1) 45 second time out per half. Clock stops during timeouts.**
- **Time and half penalties 30 seconds > 45 seconds. 60 seconds > 90 seconds.**
- **Games with goal differential of two or less will be stop time the last two minutes of games.**
- **If goal differential is four or less, the team with the lead must keep the ball in the box the last two minutes.**
- **All games ending in a tie will go into an eight-minute sudden victory OT period.**
- **Teams will start at the opposite sideline from where they finished the games. If no goals are scored after eight minutes, a one-minute break will ensue and teams will change ends.**
- **Teams will have one timeout per eight-minute OT.**
- **Quick-Start- Refs will ignore the positioning of defensive players and allow for a restart to begin with a defensive player within 5 yards. The defensive player within 5 yards must allow for an open lane to the goal and not defend the player until the restarting player creates a 5-yard gap. A violation will be a flag down (slow whistle) for delay of game.**
- **20 seconds to advance the ball over the midline-10 seconds to advance into the goal area.**
- **One handed stick checks are legal.**

Sideline Rules

- **For all LWSC games, each team is allowed up to four coaches in the team and bench area. All parents must stay on the spectator sidelines and are not allowed to be on the layer sideline. Failure to adhere to the Sideline Rules will result in the removal of the offender from the sidelines. A second offense will result in a 30 second penalty for the offending team.**
